ALICE IN WONDERLAND - CHAPTER 1

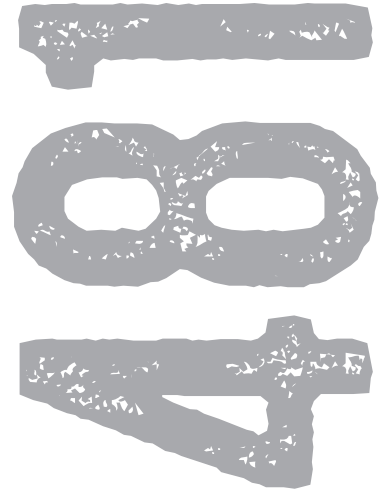
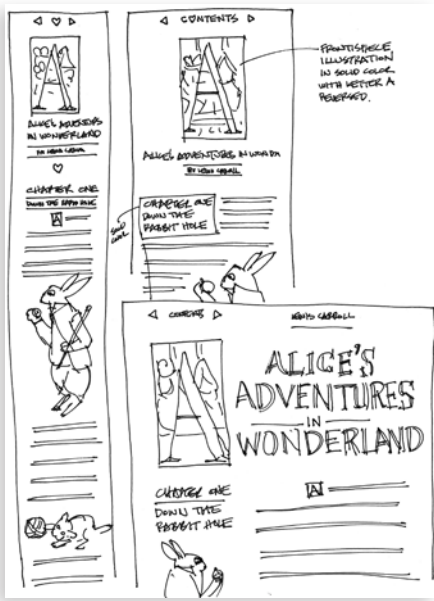
STEP 1 Draw three sets of hand-drawn roughs.

Your goal is to start defining the design and organization of your *Alice in Wonderland* website, and how it will appear on various size devices. You will need to do at least *three roughs* for each design direction (example at left is ONE design direction):

1 phone; 2 tablet/laptop; and 3 desktop computer.

Presentation Hand draw roughs on plain white paper, or use digital tablet. Turn-in PDF to Canvas. We will also have an in-class critique.

STEP 2 a Using Adobe Illustrator, create a comp for each of the three

sizes in the supplied template using the images and copy in the project assets. **b** In the same file, create a wireframe containing all of the containers you will need along with dimensions in percentages (see supplied example). **Presentation** Turn-in multi-layered illustrator file (supplied template) containing your comps/wireframes, any images placed into your layout, and a PDF which contains all comp pages. Combine all into a single zip file. **Due** Week 8, October 17 | 20 points possible

STEP 3 Using Adobe Dreamweaver, create your flexible and responsive *Alice in Wonderland* website. I will review your final webpages on a desktop computer, laptop computer, tablet and smartphone. Your website should work equally well on all of these devices. **Note** Navigation items in header and footer of page must behave like links (e.g. pointer cursor and hover effects), but do not need to actively link to other pages. **Presentation** Uploaded to your web server. You must have a link to this project in the Projects dropdown menu on your homepage.
