STEP 2 Tight layout – Using the supplied Adobe Illustrator template, create a comp and wireframe for each of the three basic device sizes.

Presentation Turn-in zip file to Canvas containing a multi-layered Illustrator file, all images placed in the layout, plus PDF file of comps and wireframes.

STEP 3 Finished site – Using Adobe Dreamweaver, create your flexible and responsive website. I will evaluate your site on a desktop/laptop computers, tablet and smartphone. Your website must work equally well on each device. Note Your site must be complete in every way (e.g. all links must function).

Presentation Uploaded to your web server as your homepage (index.html). Also, zip compress and turn in your entire site folder to Canvas.
