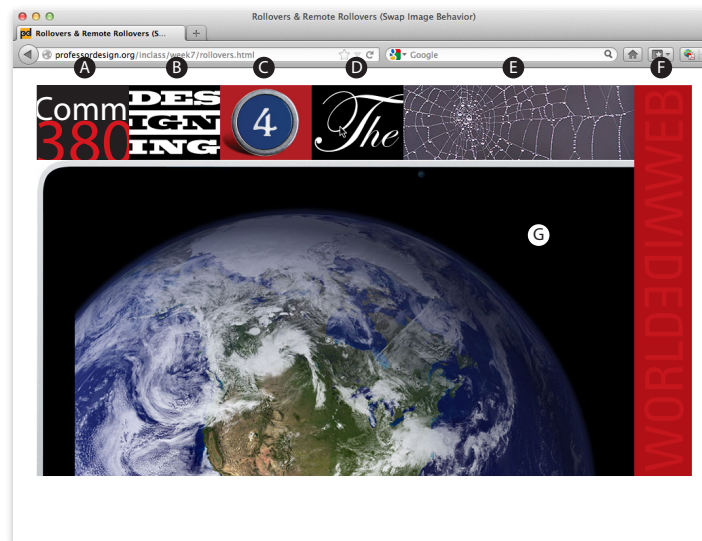

- 1 Create a new directory in your site folder called **week7**. Create a directory called **images** inside the week7 folder. Drag the supplied images into the **images** folder.
- 2 Within Dreamweaver create a new html file called **week7.html** and save it into the week7 folder.
- 3 Set up file and create divs as per demo.
- 4 Insert supplied images as shown, then create the rollovers as described below:
  - A Create a regular rollover using the Insert Rollover Image function (give an ID of **buttonA**).

Insert all remaining images where shown in example. Give each image a unique ID in the Properties window.

  - B Mark **buttonB** image. Create remote rollover (Swap Image Behavior) and swap F image (**www**) with **www\_over** image.
  - C Mark **buttonC** image. Swap E image (web) with **web\_over** image.
  - D Mark **buttonD** image. Swap G image (**world**) with **world\_over** image.
  - E Mark **web** image. Swap G image (**world**) with **surprise1** image.
  - F Mark **www** image. Swap C image (**buttonC**) with **surprise2** image.
- 5 Create a link on your index page to week7.html – have the page open in a new window (target=“\_blank”).
- 6 Due by 11:59 p.m. on Mon/Tue – .zip your **site** folder and turn it in to Canvas.
